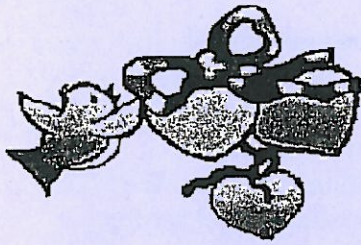
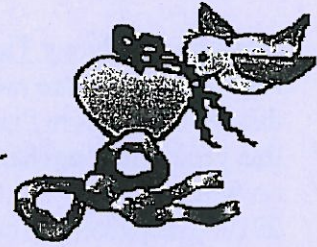





Measure A - Parcel Tax

As many of you are aware, massive state funding reductions have forced our school district to cut more than \$18 million from its budget since 2007. More cuts are expected this year, and it appears that we will be funded solely by local property taxes and receive no State revenue. Additionally, our local school parcel tax is set to expire in June of 2010. The parcel tax currently provides nearly \$3 million in local funding each year. We have put Measure A on the ballot to renew and slightly increase the existing parcel tax for another seven years. If the parcel tax is not renewed, our district will have to make an additional \$6 million in cuts on top of the \$18 million in state funding cuts. Funds generated from the parcel tax would help maintain the quality of education in our schools by attracting and retaining qualified teachers and staff; maintaining school libraries; providing middle school art and music programs; supporting small class sizes; and supporting programs which enhance student achievement. This measure will be decided by a special mail-in ballot election in February 2010. All registered voters will receive a ballot in the mail the week of January 25th and ballots will be due by February 23rd.
